Historic Hotel in Chester celebrates £27.5 million redevelopment

- The Hoole Hall Country Club & Spa a 18th Century Manor House conveniently located close to Manchester & Liverpool is completing the finishing touches on its impressive transformation and has officially been re-branded as the **Doubletree** by Hilton Chester. (*source: Reuters*)

The Langham – London – restored its Grand Ball Room and launches Langham House

- Discover the completion of an £80 million refurbishment, as **The Langham**, London re-captures its past splendour whilst offering the latest in current day technologies with fifteen function rooms including the historic Grand Ballroom and a new dedicated venue – Langham House - that blend a sense of the past with the style of today.

The Grand Ballroom - a listed space - has now been lovingly restored with subtle touches, enhancing the delicate period details that echo its past. Authentic elements have been preserved from the dramatic renaissance pillars to the sparkling chandeliers and the fine hand-painted decorative detailing. (*source: PRlog*)

Historic hotel unveils biomass heating plan

- The Dornoch Castle Hotel is to install a £75,000 biomass heating and hot water scheme in the historic 15th century building – believed to be the first on such a scale in the North Highlands.

Installation of the state of the art system – which will cut carbon emissions at the hotel by 77 tonnes a year and save over £15,000 a year in gas, oil and electricity – is about to commence and will be completed by the autumn. The hotel has received a grant of £33,700 towards the cost from the recently announced Scottish Government Scottish Biomass Heat Scheme. (*source: The Northern Times*)
